**Ten Years to Sustainability:  
The Other Gulf Problem**

In March, the United Nations Education, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) launched the Decade of Education for Sustainable Development (DESD) 2005-2014. The purpose of the DESD is to improve the public's capacity to understand social, economic, and environmental issues. It has become clear that the ability to recognize and understand the inter-relationships among these issues is critical in order to assign realistic priorities to strategies that will address resource shortages, wars and civil unrest, economic chaos, and environmental degradation. Providing practical education that enhances critical thinking skills is the primary goal of Enviroinic Foundation International for the Decade.

The speaker will first offer a brief status report identifying what is planned for the Decade and who will be involved. He will then present a practical methodology for integrating sustainability education quickly across entire campus curricula that is being considered internationally.
