# President Bush's Clear Skies Initiative

The President's Clear Skies Initiative would make considerable advances in reducing power plant emissions by requiring mandatory cuts of sulfur dioxide, nitrogen oxides, and mercury by an average of 70% from today's levels. Ms. Judith Katz, Director of the Environmental Protection Agency's Regional Air Protection Division will be discussing interesting aspects of this Initiative including the Clear Skies Initiative vs. the Current Clean Air Act, emissions trading resulting from this proposal, the health and environmental benefits resulting from Clear Skies, and a status of legislation submitted to Congress to implement Clear Skies.
