Connect & Share

1. Join the same wireless network as the Solstice display, open a web browser on your device, and browse to the IP address visible on the display.





Click 'Connect!' to download the client software app. Then launch the downloaded app to connect to the Solstice display.

If a password or screen key is required to connect, a dialogue box will appear. Enter the password, or find the screen key in the lower left corner of the display.

The Solstice SHARE panel appears upon connection. Select something to share from the sharing options available.




Using the Solstice App

1. When the Solstice app is launched, the CONNECT panel will list displays for connection. Click to connect to a display or enter the display's IP address.



2.

If a password or screen key is required, a dialogue box will appear. Enter the password or screen key (lower left corner of the display).

3. The SHARE panel appears upon connecting to a display. Select something to share from the sharing options available.



4.

The CONTROL panel is used to move/control shared posts on the display. Navigate between the Share and Control panels using the left side bar menu in the Solstice app.
