Registration: Registration is now closed.

Hotels: Options in University City very close to the conference venue include [The Study at University City](#) (room block [here](#)), [The Inn at Penn](#) (room block [here](#)), and [Sheraton Philadelphia University City](#) (room block [here](#)). You can of course also make a reservation at any other hotel of your choice. It is an easy and short trip from Center City to University City by taxi/Uber, public transportation, bike share, or walking.

Conference Venue: The conference venue is the Perlman Center for Political Science and Economics (PCPSE), 133 S. 36th Street (northeast corner of 36th & Walnut).
